CRITERIA FOR ENTRY

- CLASS 1 to 6:** Two (2) identical Jars per entry, minimum 500gm each
- CLASS 7 (A – C):** Two (2) identical Jars per entry, minimum 500gm each, characteristics will include firmness of texture.
- CLASS 8:** Two (2) identical Jars per entry, minimum 500gm each, chuck size minimum 70mm x 40mm per jar.
- CLASS 9:** Exhibitor to provide a suitable presentation stand
- CLASS 10:** Sections must be food grade sealed, no labels permitted
- CLASS 11:** Sections to be presented in square white plastic base with a clear lid, no labels permitted
- CLASS 12:** Two (2) identical Jars per entry, minimum 500gm each
- CLASS 13:** Two (2) identical Jars per entry, minimum 500gm each
- CLASS 14:** 500gm block, either polished or unpolished - judged on colour, cleanliness, tenacity, aroma & general appearance
- CLASS 15:** Present in a transparent PET Plastic Jar with a white lid, judged on general appearance, cleanliness, colour, hardness and flavour.
- CLASS 16:** Added value or alternative use criteria apply, Key elements are originality, innovation, presentation, quality of product maximising the natural qualities of the hive. Examples – candles, wax sculptures, honey baking & confectionary, polishes, cosmetics & skin care products, natural medicines and culinary products. A collection can be displayed as one entry.
- CLASS 17:** Two (2) identical Jars per entry, minimum 500gm each, must be homogenous batch sample, with supporting documentation. Jars are to be submitted to Airborne Honey Ltd, Leeston for laboratory testing no later than the 31st May 2017.

- CLASS 18 (A & B):** One sample required in original presentation.
