SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

- CLASS 1:** Liquid or Clear Honey – colour light
- CLASS 2:** Liquid or Clear Honey – colour medium
- CLASS 3:** Liquid or Clear Honey – colour dark
- CLASS 4:** Naturally Granulated Honey – colour light
- CLASS 5:** Naturally Granulated Honey – colour medium
- CLASS 6:** Naturally Granulated Honey – colour dark
- CLASS 7A:** Creamed Honey Light (any varietal or blend) – fine grained starter
- CLASS 7B:** Creamed Honey Medium (any varietal or blend) – fine grained starter
- CLASS 7C:** Creamed Honey Dark (any varietal or blend) – fine grained starter
- CLASS 8:** Chunk Honey presented in a liquid pack
- CLASS 9:** Traditional Wooden Whole Frame Honeycomb, $\frac{3}{4}$ or full depth.
- CLASS 10:** Traditional Wooden Honeycomb Sections, 340gm minimum nett weight
- CLASS 11:** Honey Cut Comb Section, 340gm minimum nett weight
- CLASS 12:** Beekeepers Special Reserve Honey, floral type and region must be nominated
- CLASS 13:** Inter-Bee Club Trophy – Honey type and style open, one entry per club
- CLASS 14:** Natural Beeswax Block – unbleached, polished or unpolished 500gm block
- CLASS 15:** Pollen, clean and dried
- CLASS 16:** Product of the hive, open category – recognising quality & innovation
- CLASS 17:** Airborne Honey Monofloral Honey – minimum batch lot 1200 kgs / 4 drums
- CLASS 18A:** Honey beverages alcoholic - mead, beer or other
- CLASS 18B:** Honey beverages non alcoholic – cordial type beverages
